Establishing service requires a \$5 membership fee. An additional service charge of \$25 is required for an existing home, or \$75 for a new home.

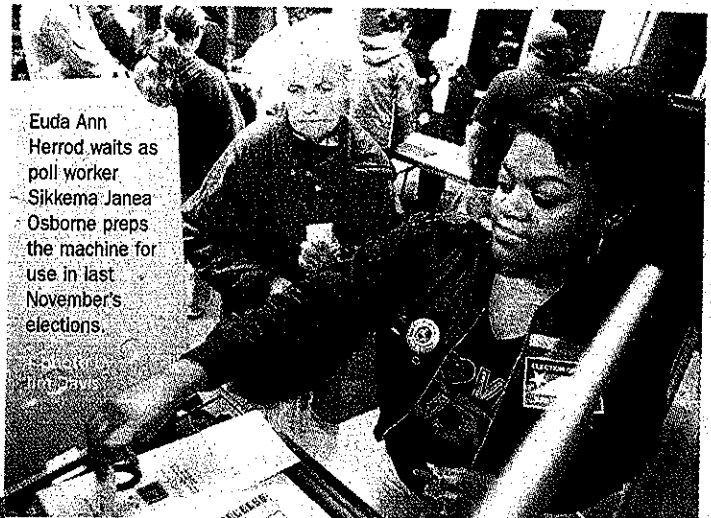

The city of Murfreesboro provides a 96-gallon cart to each single-family household free of charge. It is picked up once per week. Murfreesboro residents pay for solid waste services through local taxes so there is no monthly bill for service.
Existing homes should already have carts assigned to them but for new homes, please call Solid Waste and a cart will be delivered to that address.
